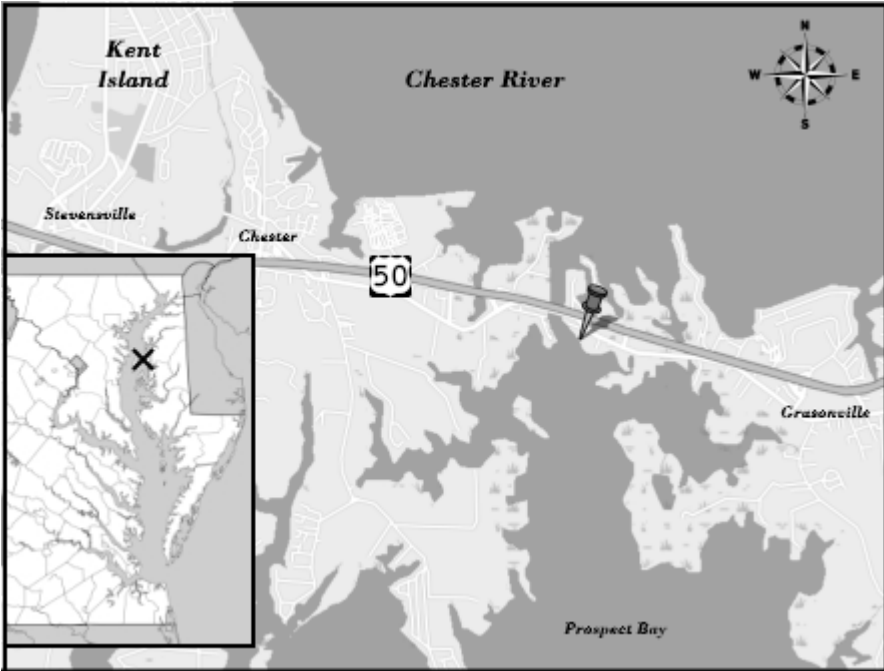

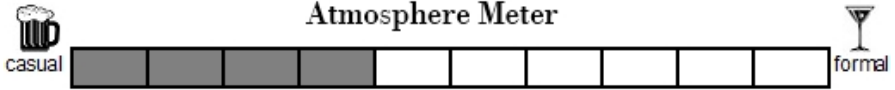

If you're looking for a one-stop shop to fulfill all your Chesapeake cuisine dreams, then head to Fisherman's Inn. Since 1930, this Kent Narrows landmark has survived everything from tough economic times to Hurricane Isabel. Somehow it keeps growing bigger and better.

The main restaurant shows its nautical roots with an aquarium at the entrance, a collection of 300+ antique oyster plates decorating the walls, and a bar shaped like a boat. A suspended toy train chugs overhead on its 280 feet of track, and two tunnels allow it to travel through the dining rooms. The menu presents an impressive display of crabs, oysters, rockfish, shrimp, and other seafood in a variety of dishes, along with pasta, beef, chicken, salads, and sandwiches. The Nauti Mermaid Bar features a long wooden bar, inlaid blue glass with waves and fish, and brass mermaid artwork hung on exposed brick walls.

At the more casual crab deck, the kitchen steams, grills, or fries local crabs, shrimp, rockfish, oysters, clams, and other catch that watermen deliver daily. Rolls of paper towels, brown paper on the tables, and the aroma of Old Bay in the air leave no doubt that this place is the real deal for a traditional crab-picking experience.

Favorite pastimes at this destination are watching a band with a cool beverage in your hand or inspecting boats as they pull into the dock. And if you want to replicate some of the dishes you eat here, Fisherman's Inn Cookbook is available online with recipes and history about the Bay.
